

## Making Headlines

**June 26, 2010** – The Courier-Journal, WHAS, and WFPK – provided coverage of a public witness against torture coordinated by the Louisville Torture Abolition Project, of which the AMC is a sponsor. Over 150 countries either practice, sponsor or condone the use of government sponsored torture. Those participating in the public witness offered educational materials to passer-by's and asked for signatures demanding an independent inquiry into the use of torture by the United States. On Thursday, June 24, the AMC hosted the showing of "Ending U.S. Sponsored Torture Forever" followed by an opportunity for reflection, dialogue and inter-faith prayer.

**March 22, 2010** – the Courier-Journals religion writer, Peter Smith, highlighted a program offered by the Angela Merici Center in his article, "Some locals focus on spirituality, not religion." The program, "I'm Not Religious...but I am Spiritual," met for four weeks in January and those attending were invited to dialogue around the questions: What is Spirituality?
